CHANJE MOVEMENT Our Story

In January 2010, a devastating earthquake rocked Port au Prince, Haiti, causing the deaths of more than 250,000, the permanent displacement of more than one million, and total social, economic and political disruption. Moved by compassion, hundreds of charitable organizations, churches and ministries redoubled their efforts and began new initiatives to help meet the physical and spiritual needs of the people.

In partnership with several organizations, the vision for the Chanje Movement was born. **Chanje is the Haitian Creole word for change and transformation**. Our own involvement with Haiti has demonstrated how individuals with compassion for others can partner together and make an enormous and eternal difference in the world.

Since that fateful day, Chanje Movement has become deeply involved with community reconstruction, leadership training, spiritual formation, microenterprise, helping orphans, and providing food and safe drinking water. We are bringing a hope and a future to the children of Haiti through community transformation and revival.

The people of Haiti continue to face unimaginable tragedies. The global pandemic and the 2021 assassination of the country's president plunged the country into chaos. In the cities, police are overmatched and gangs fight for control of the streets. Gas stations are empty because the tankers cannot deliver without paying criminals for access to the roads. Kidnappings for ransom are commonplace. Cholera is on the rise. Famine is a threat to the entire nation.

However, the people of Haiti are resilient and our work is just beginning. All proceeds raised from the 2024 Chanje Gala *A Night of Hope* will go towards helping orphans, food & water, medical care, education, family reunification, counseling, and outreaches. Will you join us in our mission?



CHANJE MOVEMENT Sustainable Development Goals

The United Nations created 17 world development goals to create "peace and prosperity for people and the planet, now and into the future." These goals are referred to as the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) or the Global Goals. While they are all important and interrelated, Chanje Movement fulfills 6 sustainable goals through our work in Haiti.





CHILDREN'S SHELTER

At Chanje Lakay, abandoned children receive clean water, nutritious meals, a safe and loving home, education, healthcare, and spiritual discipleship. Chanje Movement partners with caregivers, community leaders, local pastors, and IBESR (Child Protective Services in Haiti) to develop sustainable transformation. We are feeding, teaching, and equipping a new generation to bring change to their nation.

FAMILY REUNIFICATION + SUPPORT

We believe that in most cases, the best place for a child to grow up is in a home with their own family. Our Family Reunification and Support program helps families that want to care for their children but do not have the resources to do so. In Family Reunification, we are working with families who have a child at Chanje Lakay and want to regain custody. In Family Support, we come alongside struggling families so that they can choose to keep their kids at home. In both cases, Chanje Movement is providing financial resources for food and education, as well as a dedicated Haitian social worker to help families navigate complex situations.

FOOD OUTREACH

Chanje Movement always seeks to empower people rather than embrace dependency. But the sad reality is that Haiti's infrastructure has deteriorated to the point that self-sufficiency is nearly impossible. Extreme inflation has caused food prices to skyrocket (far more than they have in the US). Gangs now control much of the land where the food is grown. Jobs are very limited, and nearly half of the population is starving. We must act now - we can't wait for the world to intervene and fix Haiti.

Despite ongoing gang wars, our food outreach team continues to travels throughout the regions of Port au Prince and Northern Haiti to distribute hot meals and meal kits to the poor. Each kit includes enough rice, beans, spaghetti and oil for about 10 meals.

CLEAN WATER

Haiti has had multiple cholera outbreaks since 2010. Less than 50 percent of the rural population has access to clean water. This is because rural areas often depend on piped water systems that require hand pumps.

Chanje Movement has partnered with a local non profit to build two wells in Port au Prince so that communities have access to clean drinking water. The wells are built using machinery to dig deep enough to get fresh water, with additional options to install a pump system and connect the water supply to filtration to create clean drinking water.

MEDICAL OUTREACH

Medical care has become increasingly more difficult to access in Haiti over the past 2 years. Gangs are targeting doctors and hospitals. Many medical professionals have been kidnapped, killed, or have fled the country.

The Chanje Movement employs a full-time medical director that cares for all children at Chanje Lakay, ensuring they receive necessary treatment and regular preventative care, most of the time without having to leave the shelter. He and his team also conduct community clinics in the surrounding communities. For many people, these clinics are their only opportunity to see a doctor.
